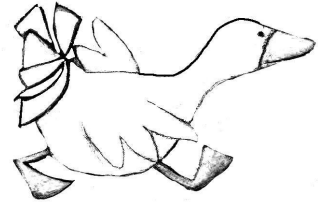


Five Little Ducks Went Out One Day



1. Counting forwards and backwards
2. Each duck has their own colour. Which colours are they?
3. Each duck takes part in an activity Talk about that activity, asking the children questions about what they do when they go to...
 - Park – things children do in the park.
 - Library- borrowing books, library card and rhyme times.
 - Farm – farm animals their noises and signs.
 - Seaside- act out building a sand castle and knocking it down, listening to a shell, and being nipped by a crab.
 - Cake shop- ask everyone what their favourite cake is.

A different nursery rhyme can be sung at the end of each flap

- Park - See Saw Margery Daw
- Library - Twinkle, Twinkle, a favourite of any rhyme time
- Farm – Old MacDonald’s Farm
- Seaside- One, Two Three, Four, Five, Once I Caught A Fish Alive
- Cake – Pat-a-cake

Make the duck hat for role-play. Print it onto card. Children should try to cut it out themselves. Decorate with crayons, feathers, glitter etc.

My Little Duck is... Draw a picture and tell/ write the story about where the little duck is going e.g. the cinema, a party, to the moon in a rocket.
